As a Parent

Expect your child to have a safe and happy camp experience. Thoroughly modern facilities include many safety features such as smoke alarms in each sleeping room and fire retardant mattresses. The kitchen and dining hall pass all Health Department inspections with good marks. The University of Tennessee Institute of Agriculture's safety officer inspects all camp facilities and helps keep them clear of hazards. Our camp is accredited by the Camping Association which has very strict requirements. No one can guarantee that your child will not get hurt, but we do all we can to minimize the risks at the 4-H center.

There is a first-aid station located on the campgrounds, and local hospitals provide care in case of an emergency. A health care professional is employed by the 4-H Center. Medications for allergies and other illnesses are kept in a safe location and monitored by adults. It is the responsibility of the parents to notify 4-H agents of any medical conditions which may apply to their child.
