Coffee-Franklin-Warren County Junior Livestock and Dairy Show

Our Coffee-Franklin-Warren County 4-H Livestock Show will be held Thursday, June 28 at the Coffee County Fairgrounds. Our Sheep and Goat Show will begin at 5:00 p.m. We have a cookout beginning at 6:30 p.m. and the Beef and Dairy show will begin at 7:00 p.m.

The sheep show will feature Sarah Weaver exhibiting her Dorper sheep. The beef cattle show will include Hereford, Angus and Limousin heifers which are registered with their breed association. The beef cattle show will also include Commercial Heifers and Market Steers. The dairy show will include Blake Teal exhibiting his Ayrshire, Holstein and Guernsey heifers and cows.

Private Applicator Pesticide Certification Class

We will have a Private Applicator Pesticide Certification Class on Tuesday, June 26 from 9:00 a.m. till 12:00 Noon at the UT-TSU Extension Office – Coffee County located in the Coffee County Administrative Plaza. If you do not have card or your card has expired and you need to purchase Restricted Use Pesticides, you will need to attend this class, pay a \$50 fee to the University of Tennessee Extension and a \$25 fee to the Tennessee Department of Agriculture. This certification is for producers who do not have a Private Applicator Pesticide Certification card or producers who have Private Applicator Certification cards which have expired!

Remember, you need Private Applicator Certification, if you are using herbicides containing dicamba! This will give you a Tennessee Private Applicator Certification card which will allow you to purchase Restricted Use Pesticides. If you have questions, call our UT-TSU Extension Office.
