



## HOW TO USE Kroger community rewards

- Register online at [krogercommunityrewards.com](http://krogercommunityrewards.com)
- Be sure to have your Kroger Plus card handy and register your card with your organization after you sign up.
- If you do not yet have a Kroger Plus card, they are available at the customer service desk at any Kroger.
- Click on "Sign In/Register"
- For new online customers: click on "SIGN UP TODAY" in the 'New Customer?' box.
- Sign up for a Kroger Rewards Account by entering zip code, clicking on "Favorite Store," entering your email address, creating a password, and agreeing to the terms and conditions
- You will then get a message to check your email inbox and click on the link within the body of the email.
- Click on "My Account" and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step.
- Click on "Edit Kroger Community Rewards information" and input your Kroger Plus card number.
- "Update" or "Confirm" your information.
- Enter NPO number **78369** or **Gibson County 4-H**
- To verify you are enrolled correctly, you will see your organization's name (Gibson County 4-H) on the right side of your information page.
- REMEMBER, purchases will not count for our group until after you register their card(s).
- Do you use your phone number at the register? Call 800-576-4377, select option 4 to get your Kroger Plus card number.
- Swipe your registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to your registered Kroger Plus card when shopping to begin raising funds for Gibson County 4-H Programs!
