How it works: Once you decide which camp is best for you, complete the form below and return it and your \$36.00 deposit to the Gibson County UT-TSU Extension office by JANUARY 27th. Once your deposit is received, you will receive ONE box of candy beginning February 1st. Once you sell your 60 candy bars and return the money, \$24.00 will be deposited into your camp account. You may sell as many boxes as you like, but can only check out ONE box at a time. Please see the complete list of rules in the contract (on reverse side). Candy For Camp Contract

Please carefully read the following agreement before signing.

- I understand that a \$36.00 deposit is required before receiving my first 60 bars(1 box) of candy.
- I understand that the \$36.00 deposit will be applied to my camp account at the end of the sales cycle, should I return all of my money from each box of candy.
- I understand that I can only receive ONE box of candy at time and each box must be paid in full before receiving the next box.
- I understand that I will earn \$24.00 toward my camp fee per every 60 bars of candy.
- Candy sales cycle will be from February 1, 2017 to March 31, 2017.
- I understand that all money from my candy must be returned to the 4-H office by the end of each cycle.
- I understand that I am responsible for the cost of any lost or unreturned candy.
- I understand that all candy money is good for the 2017 camping season only. Funds will not be rolled over and cash cannot be received. In the event you choose not to attend camp, your money will be forfeited and put into a camping scholarship fund.
- I understand that I am not allowed to sell candy bars at school.
