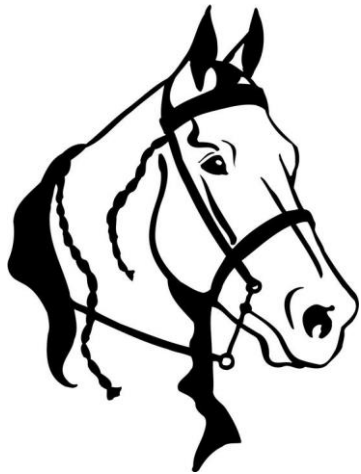

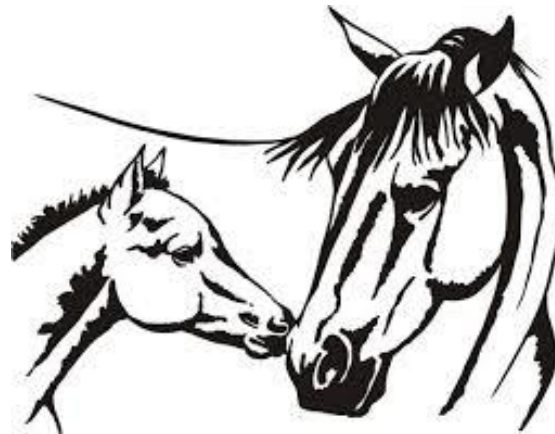
Who is Horse College For?
