To enter, simply email a clear photo of your poster along with a clear photo of you holding your poster to mcminncounty4h@hotmail.com

Rules:

- Entry must include **2** photos, 1 of the poster and one with the 4-H'er holding the poster.
- Posters must be made by the 4-H'er.
- Poster design must be **horizontal**.
- Posters can be made on a **half** a sheet of poster board **OR** on a full-size piece of plain paper (no lines)
- Name, school, teacher and grade of the 4-H member should be included in the email.
- 4-H is to be the topic for the poster.
- **Must include the 4-H Emblem.**
- Please, do not place text or other images over or on top of it. The 4-H Emblem should not appear screened under words or graphics. No photo, drawing, symbol, word or other figure or object maybe be placed on or obscure the 4-H Emblem.
- No copyrighted material may be used.
- Three dimensional objects or materials which extend **1/8 inch or more above the surface** of the poster may not be used.
- **Absolutely no glitter**



Posters are due by October 31st!

The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd county wide contest winners will receive a cash prize sponsored by McMinn County Farm Bureau Women. These posters will be entered in the regional contest.
