4-H Livestock Project Groups



The 4-H livestock program helps youth learn about the selection, feeding, caring, production, breeding, showing, management, marketing and health of their animals. Youth will become more confident as they take on this responsibility of raising a young animal and see that hard work and education pays off.

Listed below are the program and upcoming dates:

- Clarksville Area Better Beef Steer Show—4-Hers can weigh in 1 or 2 Steers in **December 2020**. Show and Sale is held in **May 2021**.
- County 4-H Poultry show and Sale--4-Hers receive 15 baby chick pullets in **April 2021** and bring back 3 when they are about 20-25 weeks old for show and sale in **September 2021**.
- County 4-H Market Lamb Show and sale--4-Hers can receive 1 or 2 Market Lambs in **May 2021**. Show and Sale is held in **July 2021**.
- 4-H FACE for Wildlife Contest-- 4-Hers receive 1 bag of seed in **May or June 2021** to plant on their Farm or property. The seed provides food and cover for wildlife.
- Regional and State Meat Goat, Market lamb Breeding Ewe and Beef Shows; which include Heifers and Steers are held in the Summer Months at various locations in Middle and West Tennessee.
