



# 4-H Monthly Service Projects!

**Up to 100 Points will be added to your Monthly Club Score!**

**November: Operation Christmas Child**

- Collect Items to be placed in a shoebox to be given to needy children around the world. Refer to handout in class for items to be collected. Items will be picked up the week of Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Clubs will receive points based on the number of items collected up to 100 points. 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade 4-H members collecting items will be given credit for 4-H Fun Day.

**January: Canned Food Drive**

- Collected food for our local Food Banks. Each grade will collect the following items. 1 Point per item!

4 <sup>th</sup> Grade =	Canned Green Beans - Regular Sized Cans only!
5 <sup>th</sup> Grade =	Canned Peaches - Regular Sized Cans only!
6 <sup>th</sup> Grade =	Canned Corn - Regular Sized Cans only!
7 <sup>th</sup> & 8 <sup>th</sup> Grade =	Cake Mix in a Box or Peanut Butter in 16oz plastic jars



**February: “Take Pride in Your School Project”.** 4-H members are asked to help your school by collecting items to use in your school classrooms. Items that can be collected are pencils, paper, dry erase markers, hand sanitizer, Kleenex, Clorox Wipes, or others items that your school needs.
