School Team Selection Procedures for 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade Students

Changes for selecting the 2018 School Teams for 6th, 7th and 8th grade.

Subject areas: 4-H, Tennessee, Agriculture, Government, Science, and Life Skills
Questions: 4-H Members will be responsible for all questions in their grade level for school contest
Team Selection Test: 4-H members will complete a written test to become a team member.

Procedures:

School Teams will be chosen by a Clover Bowl written test at each school. Each class can have 4-H members enter the clover bowl competition. Each club member who enters will compete for a spot on their School's Clover Bowl Team in their Grade Division. 4-H Members will do this by answering Clover Bowl questions on a written test. This test will take place during your February, 2018 4-H Club Meeting.

The 4 members with the highest scores in the run-off will be chosen for their schools Clover Bowl Team. Team members will then study and compete at the County contest which will be the normal quiz bowl format.

In the even that student test scored tie a randomly selected tie breaker question will be used to break the tied scores.

How to prepare for the Clover Bowl Written Test?

Students are to study all questions in their grade level!
