**Reproduction:** Improve profitability by enhancing reproductive performance.

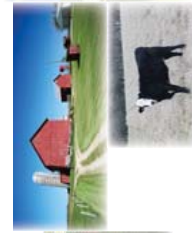
**Health:** Control diseases by maintaining health and vigor with a herd management protocol.

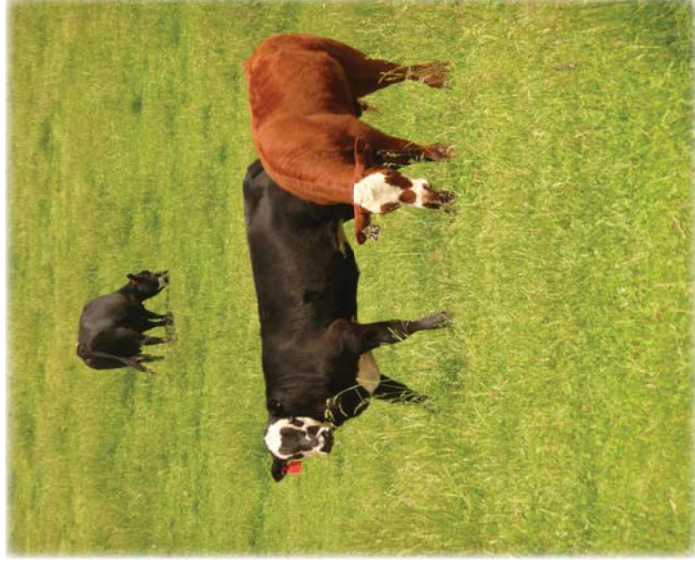
