**4-H Service Learning Chairman of the Year**

A 4-H Service Learning Chairman of the Year will be selected from those Service Learning Chairman turning in a service learning scrapbook. A scrapbook should include copies of the service learning activity report form for projects your club completes. You may include pictures of your club completing the projects. Scrapbooks are due with all other 4-H records on April 1. All entries receive certificates and ribbons. A \$25.00 check will be presented to the top service learning chairman in the county.

**Completed Project Records &  
The Golden Eagle Award**

4-H project records and the Golden Eagle Award forms are due April 1, at your school. To qualify for the Golden Eagle Award, you must complete the required activities on the form and submit complete 4-H records in your project folder. Completed records include all the following:

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade** - Complete the activities in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade book and write a 4-H Story. Show you have completed each activity by answering the questions listed with each activity.

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade and Up** - Do all the suggested activities on the project sheet. Show what you have done in the project by completing the record forms that came in your folder. This includes the plan, the report form and project story. Follow each step in the guidelines that came in your project folder.

**4-H Pet Show**

The 4-H Pet Show will be held on Saturday, March 21, at 9:30 a.m. at Mtn. Brook Village – Sevierville. Mtn. Brook Village address is 700 Markhill Drive, Sevierville. This is a fun show. Animals must be under control.

Our purpose is to share pets with Mtn. Brook Residents and other 4-H members. You may bring your pet in costume if you like.

You may enter one pet at the show. A donation of \$5.00 will be taken at the show. You must call to pre-register your pet by March 19<sup>th</sup>. Call 453-3695 ask for 4-H/Glenn Turner and leave a message at any time. Leave your full name, type of pet, grade and school. The pet show is inside this year, so it is important that your pet be under control.
