Classes

- (1) Its Electric** - Build a lamp! Learn about electricity and build a useful project. Bring your favorite soft drink can to wire and make a great little lamp to take home.
- (2) Sewing A-long** - Learn to use the sewing machine and make a special project.
- (3) Burlap Wall Hanging** – Make a wall hanging from burlap.
- (4) Goopy Science** – If you like science experiments you will enjoy this hands on class.
- (5) Memory Boards** - Make a memory display board for your room or for a gift.
- (6) Woodworking** - Let’s make a bird house that you can enter in the fair.
- (7) Tie Dye** - Try your hand at the art of tie dye. You can create your own colorful t- shirt or other clothing. You need to bring the item you want to Tie Dye (50% cotton or more).
- (8) Let’s Talk Horses** - Do you love horses? Learn basic safety, knowledge and handling techniques; plus gain hands on experience with these fascinating animals.
- (9) Pizzeria** - Make your own personal pan sized snack or biome pizza. You can eat them afterwards.
- (10) Here Chick - Chick** - Learn everything you always wanted to know about poultry.
- (11) Food Fiesta** - Learn about the culture, games and food of Mexico. Let’s have a Fiesta!
- (12) Let’s Make Ice Cream** - Have you ever made ice cream or butter? Guess where they come from! We’ll make ice cream in a bag.
- (13) Creative Cupcakes** - Learn simple culinary decorating principles, such as smooth icing, leaves and flowers as you decorate your cupcake.
- (14) Advanced Cupcakes** – This class is for advanced decorators who have already taken Creative cupcake class and want to learn more.

- (15) Konnichiwa** - Explore Japan and learn about the country-experience Japanese clothing, origami, cooking and writing.
- (16) Outdoor Cookery** - Come learn about cooking in the great outdoors. Have fun cooking on a grill as you learn the basics of preparing a tasty meal.
- (17) GPS Treasure Hunt** – You will work with GPS equipment and go on a GEO search “for treasures” hidden throughout the fair- grounds.

- (21) Ready Aim Fire** - Stay on target with this 4-H Shooting Sports with Air Rifle(s). Learn basic safety, responsibility and shooting techniques.
- (22) TWRA-Wildlife** - Explore wildlife, learn about pelts, skins, tracking and so much more!
- (23) Gifts In A Jar** – Jars are used for many thing now. Make a special gift for someone.
