The theme is **"Where Do We Get Our Food?"** Farm Bureau is sponsoring this contest with cash awards of \$50, \$25, and \$15 for first, second, and third place. This contest is only for fourth graders. The theme phrase should be included on your poster. The poster can be turned horizontal or vertical.

All posters should be 14 by 22 inches and should not have anything sticking out from the paper more than 1/8 inch. Be sure to write your name and teacher on the back of your poster. Posters can be made with any kind of media including drawing, photos, computer printouts, magazine cutouts, markers, etc.
