## Poster Contest - January

The 4-H Promotional Poster Art Contest will be held at the January 4-H Meetings. Think of your poster as a giant sign on the interstate that is advertising 4-H. Be creative, choose a simple theme, and make a poster that promotes 4-H. Winning posters usually include the 4-H Clover.

All posters should be 14 by 22 inches horizontal and should not have anything sticking out from the paper more than 1/8 inch. Be sure to write your name and teacher on the back of your poster. Posters can be made with any kind of media including drawing, photos, computer printouts, magazine cutouts, markers, etc. Try not to use well-known or copyrighted characters.

## Volunteer to do a Demonstration

Do you miss getting to do show and tell? Here is your chance to do something, make something, or learn about something related to 4-H. Choose a fun topic and plan to show off your skills or knowledge at your next 4-H Club Meeting by doing a 2-5 minute demonstration.
