Higher numbers of 4-H'ers should follow the same formula as established above. The formula is gender specific. Adults can substitute for teens, but teens cannot substitute for adults. Every effort should be made to allow all eligible 4-H'ers to participate. Camp participation should not be limited because of a lack of leaders. Every effort should be made to house leaders in the cabin with the boys or girls they chaperone.

**Payment of Leaders**

Counties are responsible for matching chaperone to camper ratios on paper. Counties are allowed to share leaders, but this must be identified on paper. The 4-H Centers will cover the cost of 1 leader per eight campers. The cost of any additional leaders will be paid by their respective county.
