## 4-H Camps

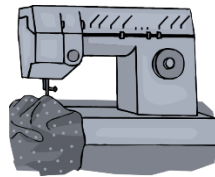

Want to earn some money for the crafts and food items you have learned to make this year? Well enter your items in the WTS Fair. Since you



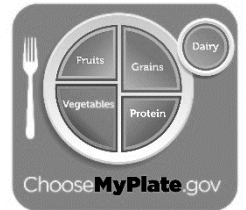
have your local club contest and you are entering the items, why not enter them in the fair and have a chance at winning up to \$3.00 for
